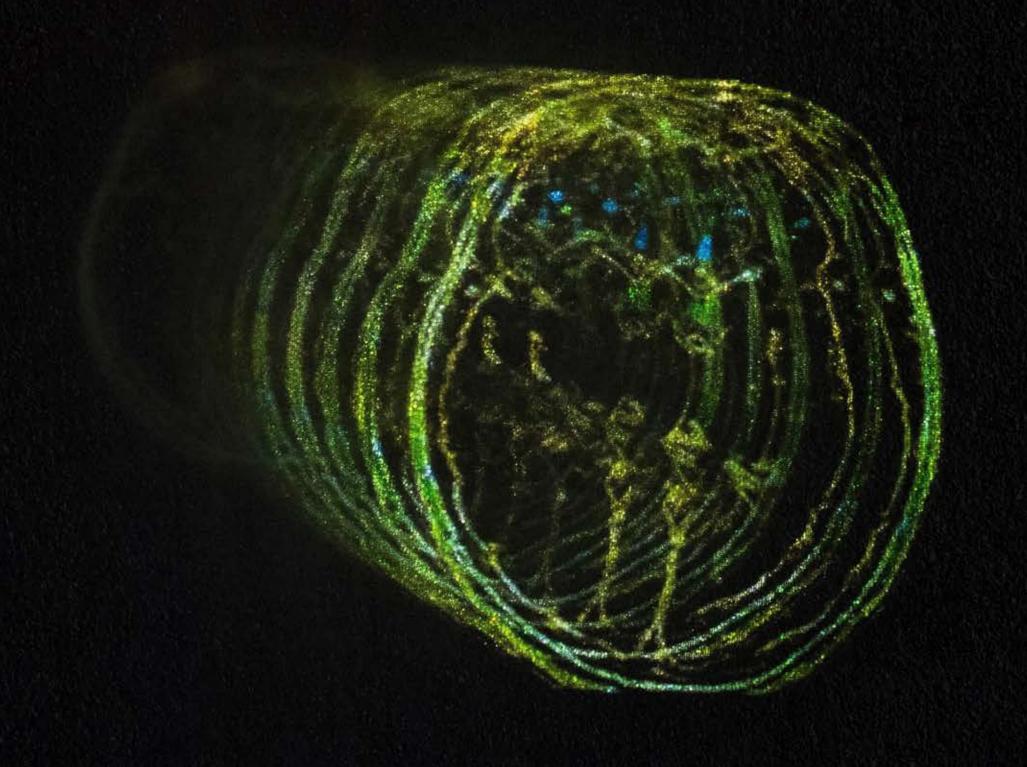
In the essay "The Poetics of Dust: Sebald and the Failure of Document" the following part attracted my attention: "During the process, errors in the document are repeated and put into question; while the 'document crash' is not resolved, it has been shown that continuous engagement with a lack of solution is the only way that the document retains its value." Archiving of the human figure in my work is recorded through the dichotomy of kinetics and statics related in time. The chosen technique brings the viewer into a correlation with time and space that, in the recurrent video, destroys the orientation in time and introduces the dimension of the infinite, or preserved (the archived) moment.

Starting from an unusual source - the essay by Alia Zapparova on Sebald's (Winfried Georg Sebald 1944- 2001) use of photographic documents in his novels The Emigrants and Austerlitz, in which the author raises arguments about the speculative nature of historical documents and their inevitable failure in providing us with reliable knowledge, Tijana Jevrić makes a connection with the branch of neuroscience which studies the concepts of simulation and virtual reality. "Documents point not to an authentic foundation that would guarantee truth, but to emptiness, an incomprehensible lack."6 Tijana uses such premises to raise the question about the possibilities of "archiving" the human being, not through its physical possessions, leftovers and all that falls into the category of a material legacy, but to record its brain functions, register millions of neurones that are connecting, colliding and intertwining thus creating the phenomena like imagination or speech. This physiological understanding of the archive allows us to think of our own bodies as depositories of experiences, archives of touches, as recording devices of our interaction with the physical world. To demonstrate her ideas, Tijana uses a magnetic resonance video of the brain's functioning that she projects onto multiple layers of translucent fabric. By using a medical document as a piece of aesthetic evidence, similarly to a documentary photograph, she highlights the dichotomy between the static, archived and the continuous, endless space. -Mia Ćuk

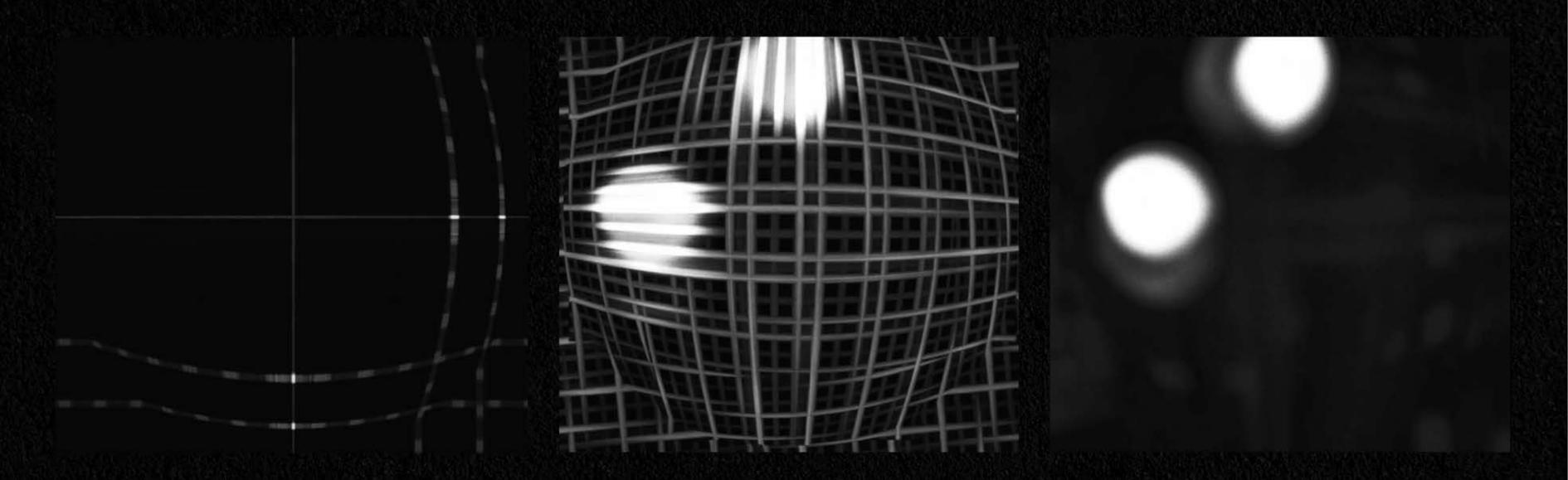

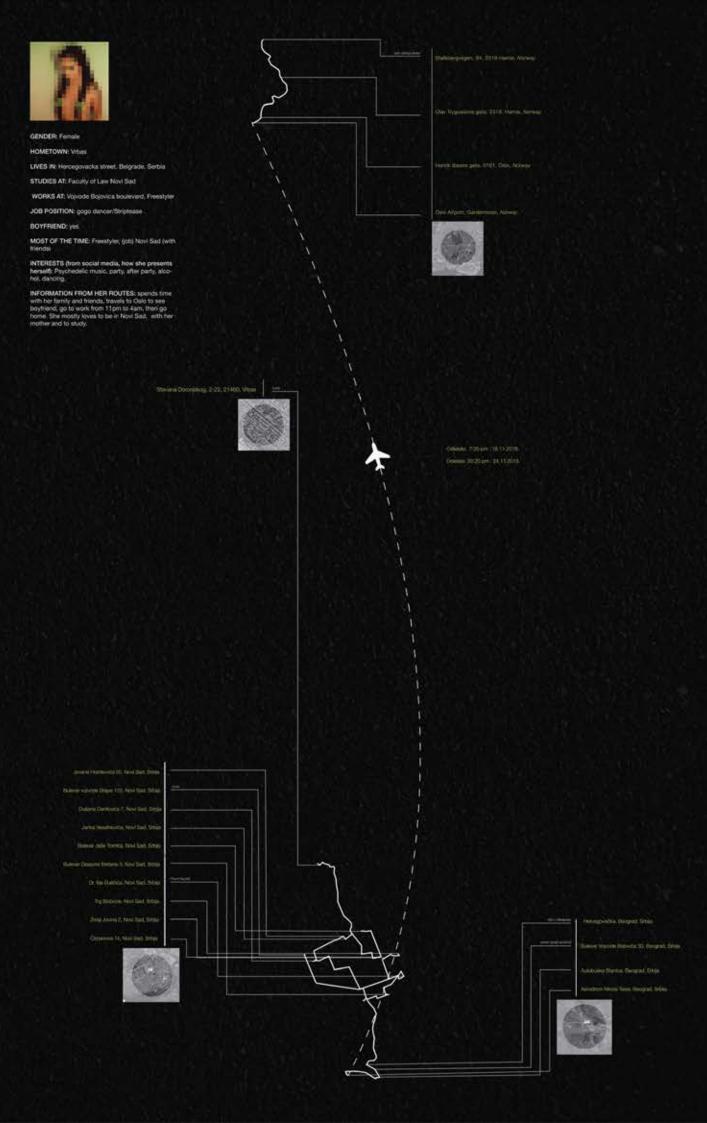

The work is based on the research of modern surveillance culture - social media as a window to an individual's every-day life. Through publicly available meta data anyone can gain access to someone's private life and to get to know someone who we have never even met in real life. Like Sophie Calle, Tijana J. researches just how possible it is to form a solid picture of a person based on a mere presence of an individual on social networks. Using a work map which depicits all characteristics of the individual she chose to follow ("stalk") she questions the modern way of analysing someone's personality through technology. Her work is a critique of so-called privacy of data in today's technology based society, while also giving insight to the creaation of our own image and the influence of technology on mediation of our persona towards the outer world.
